All of our uniform is now available through the Tesco website and at Shah's in Scunthorpe.

Acceptable school uniform:

Our school uniform policy lists those items that can be worn in school. It does not state what cannot be worn, as that would be an exhaustive list.

- Dark grey or black trousers, school shorts or school skirt
- Brumby logo jumper or cardigan (long sleeves)
- School Tie
- Blue and White checked summer dress
- Grey or black pinafore dress
- Brumby logo white polo shirt
- Dark low-heeled shoes (modern, completely-black, shoe-trainers are acceptable)
- In cold or wet weather, black boots are acceptable

Non uniform days (or school visits where uniform is not required)

Children should wear clothes that are deemed appropriate by the school on these days. If a child or parent is unsure, they should ask the class teacher before the day takes place.

For P.E:

Children in Years 3 to 6 are required to bring the following P.E kit into school:

- A pair of soft plimsolls or training shoes
- White sport socks
- Black or navy-blue shorts or p.e. skirt
- White or blue Brumby logo or plain round-necked T-shirt (no collar)

During the colder months (or on cooler summer days) KS2 pupils are also asked to bring warmer outdoor games clothing such as tracksuits or sweatshirts.

Please label each item of clothing with your child's name. This is vital as it means that items of clothing can be easily returned. Each year group has around 120-130 pupils, so unnamed items are very easily lost!
