This half term we would like you to complete a creative project all about our book Stig of the Dump and the Stone Age. You can be as creative and imaginative as you like. You may make models, draw pictures, use ICT, write poems or stories. The choice is yours! You have almost 3 weeks to complete your challenge. Here are some more ideas.

Art and Craft	Make a miniature model of or draw Stig's den. You might want to collect recycled materials to use or draw some of the things Stig could have in his hideout.
History	Make a poster, leaflet or fact-file all about the stone age. Include pictures, facts and present it in an eye-catching and interesting way.
Geography and Computing	Find out about some of the places the first people lived during the stone age. Use the internet to find out what the world was like during the Stone Age.
Design Technology	Create your own stone age meal. What kind of diet would a Neolithic human live on during the stone age?
Art	Draw, paint or create your own cave art from the stone age. This could be a hunting scene or a stone age style painting of your family.
Writing	Write a story about a new adventure for Stig and Barney. What happens in your story? How does Barney or Stig react? Who saves the day?
Art/History	Invent your own caveman or woman. This could be a model or a picture. What is his or her name? Where do they live? What tools and weapons do they use?

This is a homework project for your child to complete over 3 weeks. It is designed to be an exciting homework challenge which gives children the chance to be creative and build on their learning in school. This half term, we have chosen the theme of The Stone Age to link with our Literacy text Stig of the Dump.
