Year 3 Spring Term 2 Homework Challenge: Nature Detective

This half term we would like you to complete a creative project all about all things natural. Plants, insects, animals you choose! You can be as creative and imaginative as you like. You may make models, draw pictures, use ICT, write poems or stories. The choice is yours! You have 3 weeks to complete your challenge. Here are some ideas.

Art and Craft	Make a collage inspired by nature. Choose and use appropriate materials this may include some natural materials you have found.
Maths and Computing	Go on a bug, tree, leaf or flower hunt and create a tally chart to show what you discovered. Use your tally chart to create a graph showing your data.
Geography	Create a survey of physical and human features in your locality or a contrasting environment or place. Draw a map to show where the features were. Can you use coordinates?
Science and Design Technology	Design and make your own miniature living garden based on a theme of your choice.
Art	Find out about an artist who was inspired by Nature. Create a piece of artwork in a similar style.
Writing	Write a Haiku poem around the theme of nature. Remember the haiku rules. 3 lines long and 5,7,5 syllables.
Science and Design Technology	Create a new home for a creature of your choice. Research your creature's appearance, diet and habitat. Design and make the creature's new home. You can bring it into school to show or place it in your garden for your creature to enjoy.
