Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our Geography curriculum this half term, Year 5 are studying 'Our Locality.' To help support and develop your child's knowledge and understanding of our local area, we have organised an exciting visit to the 'Scunthorpe in the Making' exhibition at the North Lincolnshire museum. This local history study allows pupils to explore primary sources and discover how five villages merged to become Scunthorpe.

Your child will visit the museum in the week beginning Monday 17th July 2017, with one class attending the morning session each day. Please make a note of the date that your child will be visiting:

Monday 17th July – 5HS
Wednesday 19th July – 5JW
Friday 21st July – 5RS

Tuesday 18th July – 5HR
Thursday 20th July – 5LC

As we plan to walk to the museum so that we can further explore the local area, you will need to ensure that your child brings a waterproof jacket to school on the day of their visit. Depending on the weather, we hope to eat our lunch in Central Park on our return journey to school and ask that your child also brings a bag or rucksack containing a drink and their packed lunch. Please do not send fizzy drinks or glass bottles. If your child is entitled to free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided for them but they will still need a bag to carry it in. Your child will need to wear full school uniform for their visit and sensible shoes for walking.

We realise that this visit comes at a busy time for Year 5 with our trip to the Space Centre in Leicester, but we felt it would be incredibly beneficial to your child's understanding about the locality in which they live and an opportunity not to be missed. We have therefore heavily subsidised the visit using school funds, but we are asking parents and carers for a contribution of £2 per child.
