Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our science topic on evolution and animal adaptations, we have arranged for Year 6 pupils to visit Yorkshire Wildlife Park where they will take part in a workshop on this topic and will also have the opportunity to walk around the park to learn about the magnificent animals which reside there.

Children are not required to wear uniform for this trip as the weather may be very variable in March so we ask that children prepare for all eventualities. As we be outside for the majority of the day, children should bring a warm, waterproof jacket; other outerwear such as gloves and hats; comfy, water-proof shoes (walking shoes, trainers are preferable); and an appropriate bag to carry their pack-up in.

Pupils will need a packed lunch on the day. If your child receives free school meals, then a packed lunch will be provided. No glass bottles or fizzy drinks please.

If your child has an inhaler they must carry this at all times. Please ensure the school has up-to-date information about any medical needs your child has. The trip will take place within the usual school hours.

6LP, 6CJ and half of 6JL/SB will be going on Tuesday 13th March

The cost of this trip is £7.50 which is a reduced amount as the school is paying for the cost of transport to and from Yorkshire Wildlife Park.
