



A clothing grant for you and **£1,320** for your child's school

Did you know the council pays a clothing grant of £20 to primary school age children whose family live in North Lincolnshire and get one of these?:

- ▶ Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400.
- ▶ Income Support.
- ▶ Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance.
- ▶ Income-related Employment and Support Allowance.
- ▶ Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- ▶ The guarantee element of Pension Credit.
- ▶ Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit).
- ▶ Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190.

Alternatively, you can call one of the council's local link offices or collect a form from your child's school.

If your child attends an academy that has decided to pay clothing grants, the council will issue the grant on behalf of the academy. If your child gets a clothing grant, their school gets **an extra £1320** from the government every year so it's really important you apply for the clothing grant if you think you qualify for it.
