Dear parents/carers,

Important Information for Activities Week- 25/6/18

As you are already aware, we have an exciting week planned for all Year 6 children. Please keep this letter safe as it contains all of the information that you will need in order to be prepared for the trips.

General Information

- It will be non-uniform for all of Year 6 during activities week but we do ask that children wear sensible clothes and think carefully about the nature of the activities. The children will be doing lots of walking so comfortable footwear will be important. As usual, children will not be allowed to wear jewellery or high heels.
- Please ensure your child is on-time for school (8:45am) as we will be setting off as soon as we have registered the children.
- We ask that children do not bring mobile phones or any other electrical devices on these trips. Children may bring a book to keep them occupied on the coach if they wish.
- Children **do not need** any extra money; however, they may bring up to £5 per day to spend in gift shops or on additional drinks and ice-cream. Children will be required to look after this themselves; we cannot take any responsibility if money is lost.
- Children with asthma will be required to carry their inhaler with them at all times. If your child no longer requires an inhaler please let the office know so we can up-date our records.
- Please discuss arrangements with your child around how they will be getting home from school as this has caused confusion in the past. **All children will leave via the Cemetery Road exit at the time stated below.**
- **Ensure the school has all up-to-date medical information and contact details for your child in case of an emergency.**
- Staff will notify parents via SeeSaw and text message in the case of a delay.

Lunch

A packed lunch will be required for all of the trips except when your child goes to Funstation in Hull where a hot buffet is included. If your child is entitled to free school meals then a packed lunch will be provided. Children will be carrying this around themselves so please use a suitable container/bag. Please do not send glass bottles or fizzy drinks.

Activities

Monday - Lightwater Valley

We suggest that children bring some spare clothes in case of any sickness.

Children will leave school at 5pm.

Hatfield Outdoor Activity Centre

Water Freedom (Kayaking), Archery and Climbing

For these activities it is important that your child is dressed appropriately. The British weather can be unpredictable so we must prepare for all eventualities. Your child must also be able to climb and move freely in the clothes that they are wearing. Please do not send your child in any of their best clothes as it can be muddy.

We suggest that your child come to school wearing: jogging bottoms, t-shirt, jumper, trainers (with laces) and a water-proof jacket. They **must** also bring with them a full set of clothing (including underwear, footwear and a towel) to change into as it is **very likely** they will get wet. Children will be supplied with all safety equipment, such as life jackets, and will be closely supervised at all times.

Children will leave school at 4.30pm.

Wild Pines Park

During the day, pupils will take part in four activities: ropes course, team building games, archery and a treasure hunt. The children will be spending the whole day outside and so need to be ensure that they are dressed appropriately in clothes that they can move and climb around in freely. No skirts or high heels. Children should wear full shoes such as trainers and it is recommended that full length trousers are worn to prevent nettle stings and rope burns.

Children will leave school at 4.45pm.

Funstation at St Stephens

Children will spend thirty minutes in the Laser Station, play a game of mini bowling and be given 8 tokens to use in the arcades. They will also enjoy a hot buffet and juice which is included in the price. Pupils will leave school at the usual time of 3.05pm

Central Park

We will be taking our lunches with us to have a picnic at the park. Children will take part in some games and activities such as rounders. Again, pupils should where non-school uniform that they can move around freely in.

Children will require PE kit. Children will leave school at the usual time of 3.05pm.
