Good Attendance means...


Being in school at least 97% of the time or 184 to 190 days

Our attendance target moving forward will be 97%. To help achieve this, we have launched a number of exciting initiatives to promote this across the academy. On a weekly basis, we will celebrate class attendance during assembly. The class with the best attendance for the previous week will receive a gold medal on our attendance display, 2nd best will receive a silver medal and 3rd best a bronze. These will add up over the course of the year and the class with the most points will earn a special reward. We have also launched OJABOPOLY where every class who achieved 97% attendance or more during the previous week will roll the dice and earn a Friday afternoon reward for the class such as extra playtime, extra story time or extra Chromebook time. Finally, to celebrate individual attendance, all children who achieve 100% attendance across a term will receive a prize at the end of that term!
