Do you play an instrument or would like to?
Are you 5 - 13 years old?
Then join us on an exciting one week music-making summer school - delivered by experienced music teachers from North Lincolnshire Music Support Service.
This year we are welcoming children from an even wider age-range, meaning that any child from Reception to year 8 is catered for. Children will work together in separate age group sessions - each with experienced practitioners.

About the Summer School:

This year is our sixth year! Whether your child loves singing in a choir or on their own; plays an instrument to a high standard, or not yet at all, this week will be for them. The week caters for children between the ages of approximately 5 and 13. The summer school is proud to be run by the North Lincolnshire Music Support Service, which continues to provide high-quality musical experiences to young people of all ages.

Activities may include:

Musical games, singing, music through movement, recorder groups, ukulele groups, instrumental groups large and small, drumming, xylophone orchestra, and much more. In celebration of the participant's success, we will be providing performance opportunities throughout the week.

Lead Tutors:

Kathleen Watson studied music at the University of Hull, and has been teaching music in both secondary and primary settings for 13 years; 11 of those with the North Lincolnshire Music Support Service. Her main passions are choral singing, teaching early musical literacy, and playing the ukulele! She recently took up the post of Music Teacher at Sir John Nelthorpe School in Brigg, and also directs the Scunthorpe Co-operative Junior Choir middle training choir.

Elisabeth Brierley graduated from the University of Oxford in 2015 with a BA Hons Music. Having now returned to North Lincolnshire, Elisabeth works for Opera North as an Early Years Vocal Artist and as a peripatetic music teacher for the North Lincolnshire Music Support Service. She also conducts the Scunthorpe Co-operative Junior Choir's youngest training choir and a community choir in Winterton. Outside of work, Elisabeth enjoys performing with a local chamber choir, and also with the prestigious White Rosettes. We are excited that Elisabeth will be delivering our KS1 sessions.

Kate Marshall graduated with a degree in Music from the University of Wales, and a PGCE General Primary from St Martin's College. She taught in local primary schools for over ten years before joining the North Lincolnshire Music Support Service in 2015. Her interests include playing clarinet, saxophone and flute in a local orchestra and ceilidh band.
